3. PLANS

3.2 Major Activities

The major plans over the coming year are primarily focused on 3 areas:

- Maintaining sustainability for existing programs/committees
- Helping programs transition back out of “COVID mode”
- Seeking broader geographic representation for the board

The first of these consists of two significant activities:

- Rebooting the ACM Local Committee
- Refreshing the Case Studies Committee

The impact of COVID on local activities was, not unexpectedly, dramatic, with the level of local activities dropping off significantly. This meant that the ACM Local committee struggled to carry out its mission, with the end result being that the committee effectively shut down.

With the impact of COVID receding, we are now in a process of trying to re-build the committee. A number of potential committee members have been identified and spoken with, and there is also a candidate for committee chair. It is expected that the new committee will be up and running by the end of calendar 2022.

After a number of years of successfully running the Case Studies program, the current chair of the committee (Adam Cole) is experiencing increased demands on his time from his non-volunteer life and so we are in the process of seeking a new chair for the committee. We will also take this opportunity to recruit additional members to the committee.

As with local activities, COVID also had a substantial impact on the DSP. One positive part of this is that the DSP was able to encourage virtual speaking events and get reasonable uptake on this. It appears that in person activities are already picking up, and it is expected that the program will be operating at its pre-COVID levels soon. However, it is both hoped and anticipated that virtual speaking engagements will now be on ongoing part of the program.

All of the other committees of the board have continued to operate effectively, and the results of this case be seen in the performance metrics attached at the end of this document.

3.3 Diversity Plans

Although the board has made some progress in terms of extending geographic representation, it continues to be an area of weakness. In response to this, we are actively engaged in the process of recruiting a Vice-Chair for the board from outside the North America region. We have a number of

candidates who we will be speaking with over the next few months and hope to have the position filled by early 2023. Once this position is filled, we anticipate being able to use it as a springboard for further increases in geographical diversity on the board.
